Notice of the 87th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of The Singapore Teachers' Co-operative Society Ltd

Dear Ordinary Members,

- 1. Please refer to earlier letter dated 10 May 2023, informing members of the forthcoming 87th AGM of The Singapore Teachers' Co-operative Society Ltd ("the Co-op"), inviting nominations in accordance with the Society's By-Law for six (6) Ordinary Members to join the Committee of Management.
- 2. Notice is hereby given that the 87th AGM of the Co-op will be convened and held by way of electronic means at **10:30 AM, Saturday, 24 June 2023** to transact the following business:

No.	Proposed Resolutions
1.	To confirm the minutes of the 86 th Annual General Meeting held on 25 June 2022.
2.	To confirm the minutes of the Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) held on 30 July 2022
3.	To receive, and if approved, to accept the Report of the Committee of Management and the Audit Report for the year ended 31 December 2022
4.	To receive and if approved, to accept the audited Statement of Accounts for the financial year ended 31 December 2022
5.	To consider and approve the proposed 'Distribution of 2022 Surplus' (Annex 4)
6.	To consider and approve the Adjustments for FY 2023 and Estimated expenditure for FY 2024 for the Society. (Annex 5)
7.	To consider and approve the maximum liability of \$80 million for the year 2023, which the Society may incur in loans and deposits from members and non-members, vide by-laws 9.11 and 9.12. (Annex 6).
8.	To approve the payment of \$7,250 per month to members of the Committee of Management.
9.	To approve the payment of \$12,600 per year for the AC Committee and the Internal Auditor.
10.	To consider and appoint Messrs Reanda Adept PAC (Mr Ng Kok Keong) as External Auditor for the financial year 2023.
11.	Elections: To elect six members, five of which will serve on the Committee of Management for a term of three years. The sixth member with the highest number of votes from the remaining candidates will be elected to serve from 24 June 2023 to the AGM date in 2024. This elected member will then have to seek re-election if he/she desires to serve in the COM again.
12.	To transact any other business of which at least seven clear days' notice shall have been given in writing to the Chief Executive Officer.

- 1. The Annual General Meeting will be convened and held by electronic means pursuant to the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Alternative Arrangements for Meetings for Charities, Co-operatives and Mutual Benefit Organizations) Order 2020.
- 2. Please refer to <u>Annex A: Alternative Arrangements for AGM</u> for details of how the AGM will be conducted, including how members may electronically access the meeting, send to the chairman of the meeting substantial and relevant matters which they wish to raise, and cast their votes.
- 3. A member must appoint the chairman of the meeting as his/her proxy to attend, speak and vote on his/her behalf at the AGM if such a member wishes to exercise his/her voting rights. Please refer to Annex A for information on how the chairman of the meeting maybe appointed as proxy to vote.

Person Data Privacy

- (a) the processing, administration, monitoring, analysis and facilitation by the Society (or its service providers) of the member's participation in the AGM (including any adjournment thereof);
- (b) the preparation and compilation of the attendance lists, voting results, questions and answers, minutes and other documents relating to the AGM (including any adjournment thereof); and/or
- (c) compliance by the Society (or its agents or service providers) with any applicable laws, regulations guidelines and/or the Society's by-laws.

Annex A: Alternative Arrangements for AGM

- 1. Members will not be able to attend the 87th Annual General Meeting ("AGM") in person. Adhering to the guidelines issued by the Registry of Co-operative Societies on Alternative Arrangements for the Conduct of Meetings for Co-operative Societies, a member is deemed to be present at a meeting if the member has appointed the chairman of the meeting as his/her proxy to attend the meeting. The member may participate at the 87th AGM by:
 - a. attending or observing and listening to the AGM proceedings by electronic means;
 - b. submitting matters that they wish to raise in advance of the AGM; and
 - c. appointing the chairman of the meeting to attend, speak and vote on their behalf at the AGM.
- 2. Where a member appoints the chairman of the meeting as his/her proxy, he/she must give specific instructions as to voting (For or Against), or abstentions from voting, in respect of a resolution in the form of proxy, failing which the appointment of the chairman of the meeting as proxy for that resolution will be treated as invalid.
- 3. Following are steps for pre-registration, pre-submission of questions and voting by proxy at the 87th AGM

Pre-registration for attendance by electronic means	Members must pre-register for viewing and to participate in Question-and-Answer session during live webcast of the 87th AGM. Online pre-registration can be done by scanning the following QR code or via the Society's website www.teachersco-op.org.sg Pre-registration must be done by Thursday, 22 June at 1pm, for the Co-op to verify their status as eligible Ordinary members with voting rights. Members will also need to use Two-Factor Authentication (2FA) sent to their mobile number during registration and each time they enter the site for E-proxy or on the day of AGM live webcast. Following the verification, authenticated members will receive a confirmation email from agmaccounts@conveneagm.com before the AGM. The email shall contain instructions as well as link to access the live webcast of the AGM proceedings.
