

We look forward to a challenging and exciting future together.


Inter-School Bowling Championship 2011 5 November 2011, Orchid Bowl at the Orchid Country Club

The Inter-School Bowling Championship 2011 jointly organized by The Singapore Teachers' Co-operative Society Ltd & Ministry of Education Sports and Recreation Club received resounding response from the teachers from the various schools. 34 teams totaling 136 participants from 34 schools joined in the "strike" against the ten-pins on the morning of 5 November 2011 at the Orchid Country Club's Orchid Bowl.

Presentation of Student Welfare Grant

To fulfill the part of the Society's vision of being "A leading co-operative committed to serving its members and caring for the community", 10 schools were selected for the Student Welfare Grant 2011.

Under the Society's Student Welfare/Community Service Rules, the Society is granting a sum of \$1,800 to each school to help their pupils who need financial assistance. Since 2003, more than 42 schools had benefitted from this grant. The schools were given the discretion to allocate the money to their needy students.

This year the award ceremony was held in conjunction with the Society's Inter-School Bowling Championship on 5 November 2011 at Orchid Country Club. Principals or their nominated staff members were present to receive the cheque from the Society's Chairman.

The following schools were awarded the grant: Fernvale Primary School, Farrer Park Primary School, Opera Estate Primary School, Xinghua Primary School, Yuhua Primary School, Bedok Town Secondary School, Shuqun Secondary School, Si Ling Secondary School, Whitely Secondary School and Yusof Ishak Secondary School.



A Community Outreach Programme by Singapore Teachers' Co-operative Visit to Pertapis Senior Citizen Fellowship Home on 22 Oct 2011

A sunny Saturday morning greeted the group of students and teachers from Hai Sing Catholic School and members of the Ladies' Committee from the Singapore Teachers' Co-operative, as they made their way to Pertapis Senior Citizen Fellowship Home at Toa Payoh.

The manager of the establishment, Mr Mohammad Ali welcomed the group and gave a presentation on the history of Pertapis and its development. The organization facilitates elderly care, childcare, education, rehabilitation and halfway homes for abused women, children and destitutes. There are 40 residents in the Toa Payoh Home (20 males and 20 females).

This was followed by a sumptuous buffet lunch sponsored by the Teachers' Co-operative. The students also interacted with the residents and assisted in serving lunch.
